GENERAL

Duration 50-60 minutes

Set-up 10.30 on the day of the performance

STAGE

Minimum floor space: 8 x 8 meters

Minimum height: 6 meters to rigging point

Floor: Black marley

PLANNING For a 20.00 performance

Arrival In agreement with production, schedule below is an example.

Rigging Approx 1,5 hours (11.00 - 12.30)
Set-up band + Soundcheck Approx 1,5 hours (12.30 - 14.00)

Break Approx 30 - 60 minutes (14.00 - 15.00)

Lights Approx 1,5 hours (15.00 - 16.30)

Spacing Approx 30 minutes (16.30 - 17.00)

Rehearsals Approx 30 - 60 minutes (17.00 - 18.00)

Dinner 18.00 - 19.00 Prep/extra 19.00 - 19.30

SHOW SCHEDULE

Final sound/light checks 45 minutes prior to the show Door open 5 minutes before the show

SOUND

Live music performed by the Lingua Franca Ensemble. Please don't hesitate to communicate with us if something is not clear. Temperature of the hall during soundcheck, rehearsal, brakes and concert has to be at min. 20 'C and max. 24 'C.

Back-Line / Technical Rider

BACK LINE NEEDED:

- 3 chairs without arm-holders (about 50 cm height ±5 cm)
- 1 small laptop table (+ 2 electricity sockets)

1. Violin - Michalis Kouloumis

- 1 line XLR for Violin
- 2 Electricity sockets

2. Oud/Guitar/Vocals - Giannis Koutis

- 1 line (1/4" jack) for Oud
- 1 line XLR and condenser mic for Oud (Beyerdynamic MC930 or Neumann KM184)
- 1 line XLR and mic for Vocals(Neumann KM104 or Shure 58A Beta or DPA D:Facto II)
- 2 lines 1/4" jack (stereo) for Loopstation pedal
- 2 mic stands (1 short & 1 normal height)
- 2 instrument stands (guitar stands)
- 1 Electricity socket

3. Tarhu/Ney - Michalis Cholevas

- 3 XLR lines
- 1 instrument stand (guitar stand)
- 2 Electricity sockets

4. Drum set / Percussion - Ruven Ruppik

- Hi-Hat with stand
- 2 cymbals with stands

- Snare drum with stand
- Cajon
- 2 mic stands to hang bells, small effect percussions etc.
- 1 small table of approximately 45cm x 45cm x 45cm
- 9 lines XLR and mics:
 - X2 Overheads mics (Neumann KM184)
 - X2 mics for Marimba (Neumann KM184)
 - X1 mic for Darbuka/Rig/Frame drum (Shure SM57)
 - X1 mic for back of Darbuka (Shure SM57)
 - X1 mic for Bombo Leguero (bass drum type of mic)
 - X1 mic for Snare drum (Shure SM57)
 - X1 mic for Hi-Hat (Shure SM57)
- These are the specifications for a full Percussion set. Usually we exclude the Marimba and its requirements due to the space requirements.

- 15 lines XLR
- 8 lines for group channels *

NOTE:

For the recording session we need * 8 group channels from the mixer to our MOTU traveler in order to record on multitrack.

RIGGING

Rigging will be done by the artists in agreement with the theater. 1 technician should be available to assist if necessary. We always need the technical specifications of the venue in advance to prepare the performance. The company provides their own aerial equipment.

Technical Drawings in development

The theater provides:

2 rigging points at minimum 6 meters height

Working load limit 300 kg per point.

Acces to the rigging points by either a Genie, ladder, bridge or other safe system.

3x 15kg weight blocks for paging the aerial equipment during performance.

Black screens on the side for the artist to enter and exit the stage.

DRESSING ROOMS

2 large dressing rooms suitable for 4 people each.

Heated space, with a clean floor.

4 chairs, 1 table and 1 mirror in each dressing room.

Rack for costumes in each dressing room.

Towels

AMENITIES

Safe and free parking space for unloading materials upon arrival, loading during departure and for 2 cars during the day of the performance.

An assortment of fruit, nuts and seeds, coffee, tea and water for 7 people on the performance and set-up days. We prefer organic produce in in an effort to live a healthy and sustainable lifestyle.

Due to the physical nature of the performance, all rehearsal, performance spaces and dressing rooms should be 22-23 degrees celsius.
